Vinegar works as a milder disinfectant. Besides, it's better than bleach for cleaning mineral stains and soap scum.






Baking Soda

Hydrogen Peroxide


Hydrogen peroxide can help you brighten and disinfect almost any surface (without dangerous chlorine fumes!)
